- We are committed for complete development of women and children through women and child development department. We have been working for it since a long time. We heartily thank to WCD who always guide us to do that.
- Media and Media person who, wholeheartedly circulated stories and achievement among their reader which actually made our task easier and improved organization's image in people' mind.

Review of operations:

1-Livelihood Enhancement: Poverty elimination remains the core of all our endeavours since inception. Janmitram is operating this year **WADI** program in Gharghoda block of Raigarh district. This program aims at reducing migration of tribal people to urban centres by providing them livelihood in the form of income and basic necessities like fuel wood, timber and cattle fodder. Janmitram has successfully created 725 wadis with prime support of NABARD. This program is running from 2011, in 3 phases. Mango, cashew, Guava and lime are distributed at no cost. Fertilizers, insecticide, pesticide in appropriate proportion were applied. We provided water source at every wadi cluster, in forms of bore well, ring well, pumps and pipes etc.

We proudly say that our plant survival rate is above 95% with development of land and water resource, intercropping has become popular. We also provide loans from TDF to strengthen WRD, fence and to purchase inputs for intercrops. 65% of wadi areas are under continues intercropping, and farmers are getting 25 to 90 thousands additional income from their landscapes. Joint efforts of our team and farmers have made true miracle.

After the successful implementation of NABARD wadi project since last year, we have started the model project of wadi with MGNREGA, supported by Zilla Panchayat Raigarh, till date we have added 567 tribal families/wadi along with 725 old wadies. We are providing all kinds of business, services along with financial services to 1200 tribal farmers in Gharghoda block of Raigarh district. We have raised the slogan 'operation double income' innovation wadi project.

2-Natural Resource Management- Janmitram Kalyan Samiti is implementing watershed programme (IWMP) in Kharsia block, with the prime support of GOI. The main objective of the project is to provide minor irrigation facility to each and every farmer through "one drop and more crops". Total 3250 families are getting benefit through this program. Micro watershed committees are running smoothly the project activities with their own capacity. The farmers are concern to construct such structures which will check soil erosion and improve water availability through natural resource management to sustain their life and livelihood in the block.

3-Education (JSPS School)-

Education is the only platform where a person stands and understands the things in his own ways; here he meets his own internal consciousness. Janmitram had always a dream to start an educational institution where a child can understand easily the value of true education and life. It was intiated since 2014 by Janmitram in Gharghoda block of Raigarh district.

Presently it has 436 students in the school. The school has adapted 65 poor children to continue their education at free of cost. Those free scholar are getting education apart from RTE under government scheme. We are thankful to the people of Gharghoda who overwhelmingly responded to school and also to Give India Foundation which collected sizable support through its website to open the school. Give India also provide the donation to janmitram for school fees of poor, tribal and unprivileged children. We are committed to provide them high quality education.

4- Health over view: Targeted intervention on female sex workers-

Since 2008, JanMitram is engaged in a highly challenging programme for Targeted Intervention of Female Sex workers, to reduce their risk of HIV-AIDs and STD infection. This project is running through prime support of NACO-National AIDS control organization, State Aids Control Society. Technical assistance is being provided by Hindustan lever family planning trust.

The organization has identified 1200+ female sex workers in two towns. Both town have seen high industrialization, mining and thereby emergence of migrant workers and truckers. Overt and covert Sex-workers have increased accordingly, posing great threat of HIV spread in lower middle-income groups. Out target is to prevent new HIV and Sexual transmitted infection among these FSWs and providing counselling, medicines, condoms etc. we are trying to rehabilitate because many ladies as possibly belong to other professions too.

The promotion technique is adopted to transform their behaviour from unsafe sex to safe sex situation. Proper strategies are developed through one to one meet, focused Group discussion, Condom promotion, and condom demo/pre demo, proper counselling to change the behaviour of the High risk group(HRG) and the community. In STI Management Proper methodology is adopted to appoint communal Doctor/ Preferred Private Practitioners (PPP) as per the preferred community or FSW.

There are all facilities for free medicine and free treatment of the high-risked patient coming to their clinic. Government ICTC and referral centres are a part of STI management. Friendly atmosphere, proper counselling and personal relations are the key for success. This year we have created 124 new HRG group.



5-Activities against domestic violence: Any women afflicted by domestic violence, can get help and facilities in janmitram through more effective Protection under constitution for guaranteed rights and related with it or to provision of its consequential subjects act.

Here are facilities for afflicted women, if any activities of respondent which would may effect on afflicted person's health, security, life or maybe disservice on his mental or physical existence, or intended to do any those activities, through which he would be able to do physical, sexual, verbal, emotional and financial exploitation:

- **1- Shelter facility:** Here is 5 days temporary shelter facility for afflicted woman in janmitram, if she would request for it.
- 2- Medication facility: Here is medication facility also for afflicted woman, if she needs it.
- **3- Legal help:** legal help would be provided by janmitram on the request of afflicted woman.
- **4- Suggestions:** Suggestion facility would be provided for afflicted woman according to the order of honorable court.
- 5- To put the report of home violence in court: Afflicted woman can also record the domestic violence and put it in front of magistrate in court.

The helps for afflicted woman by court:

- 1- **Proceedings in a closed room-** Magistrate can operate the proceeding in a closed room if the afflicted woman requests and magistrate thinks by his own discretion.
- 2- **Right to live in joint family:** Each woman would has right to live in joint family among relatives.



- **3- Protection order:** When the magistrate would find that there has being done domestic violence or is about to be done then he can release out the order of protection.
- **4- Residence order:** When the magistrate would know that there has being done domestic violence in the case, and then he can release residence order in favor of afflicted woman.
- **5- Monetary relief:** Magistrate can order to respondent for pecuniary relief payment to full fill the compensation emergent of home violence of afflicted woman or her any child.
- **6- Custody order:** Under this act- magistrate can give orders for temporary protection of any child of afflicted woman or any person who applied behalf of afflicted woman, in any stage of hearing of application to have protection order or to have any other relief.
- 7- **Protest order:** According to the application of afflicted woman, the magistrate can give protest and payment orders for damages including mental and emotional purgatory done by respondent.
- 8- Interim and one sided order: Magistrate can give interim orders for the situations which would be appropriate and legitimate about the case under this act.

Janmitram compliances 'Protection of women from domestic violence act 2005' since 2015. It has arranged various seminars and other inspirational programs in last few years to stop domestic violence. Here are the details which Janmitram did at its best to prevent the domestic violence:

- **1- To put the reports of home incidents in court:** The organization has putted 77 DIR (Domestic Information report) yet this time as the service granter.
- **2- Legal advice-** The organization has provided advices for 25 afflicted women by legal adviser according to their request.
- **3- Shelter facility:** total 7 women got the shelter facility by Janmitram.

4- Medication facility: 3 women got medication facility yet this time by organization.

6-Women Empowerment (SHPI Program): Self-Help Group (SHG) is a small voluntary association of poor people, preferably from the same socioeconomic background. They come together for the purpose of solving their common problems through self-help and mutual help. The SHG promotes small savings among its members. The savings are kept with a bank. This common fund is in the name of the SHG. SHG is a group formed by the community, which has specific number of members like 15 or 20. Usually, the number of members in one SHG does not exceed twenty. In such a group the poorest would come together for emergency, disaster, social reasons, economic support to each other have ease of conversation, social interaction and economic interactions. We have successfully formed 217 SHG group in the year of 2017-18.

Main objectives of a SHG:

- To sensitize people of target area for the need of SHG and its relevance in their empowerment process.
- To create group feeling among members.
- To enhance the confidence and capabilities of members.
- To develop collective decision making among members.
- To encourage habit of saving among members and facilitate the accumulation of their own capital resource base.
- To motivate members taking up social responsibilities particularly related to development.

The SHGs comprise very poor people who do not have access to formal financial institutions. They act as the forum for the members to provide space and support to each other. It also enables the members to learn to cooperate and work in a group environment. The SHGs provide savings mechanism, which suits the needs of the members. It also provides a cost effective delivery mechanism for small credit to its members. The SHGs significantly contribute to the empowerment of poor.

Women empowerment is one of the core programs of Janmitram through SHPI program. It makes them economically, socially and psychologically strong. NABARD offered Janmitram to format 500 SHG in the year of 2016. We have



successfully formatted 427 SHG in Dharamjaigarh and Chhal block of Raigarh district.

The SHG-bank linkage program is targeted to reach the poorest sections, which are bypassed by the formal banking system. Therefore, it is essential that only the very poor be considered as the target group for the SHG -bank linkage program.

Janmitram provides them bank linkage to get the loan for different purpose. Total savings of all group in this year is 11, 51000 (in lakh).

This year (in May-June) we organized OTC (Organizational Training Camp) training in Gharghoda block of Raigarh district to enhance the livelihood of the tribes. It was basically an awareness program supported by Zilla Panchayat Raigarh. Objective of the training was to make tribes aware about the policies of state government in rural areas. 2430 participants from different villages participated at there. The training was held in JSPS school campus in Gharghoda.
